*Kennel Enrichment – Private Boarding at Stay Pet Hotel

We understand that not every dog can be socialized, and that some require smaller, and very specifically selected groups of dogs with whom to socialize. Our goal is to create the most comfortable, and enriching environment possible for our “private” boarders, and to that end, we’re going to be implementing a “kennel enrichment” program, much like those used by the Humane Society, and many other shelters and boarding kennels. Money saving daycare packages are available for all daycare services. Daycare packages are specific to each location and are non-transferrable. We offer multi dog discounts on packages as well.

We offer the first day of daycare FREE for new clients, this must be done within 60 days of evaluation or your dog may need to be re-evaluated. Also, if you refer someone to us and they use our services, you will receive one FREE day of daycare.

Boarding Info:

Reservations are required/space is limited!

Extended stay discount is available if your pup stays 14 nights or longer, you will receive a 10% discount.

Multiple dog discounts are available as well.

Check-in is before 12pm. Dogs arriving late can disrupt the daily routine. Giving your dog some time to burn off excess energy/anxiety makes it easier on all the dogs staying here.

Check out is before 12pm on the final day. After 12pm, a \$19 daycare charge will apply (per dog, if more than one).

Daycare Policies

1. All dogs must be up-to-date on vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof that dogs have received the required vaccinations within the specified time period recommended by a veterinarian.
2. All dogs must be current on flea treatment and prevention year round.
3. All dogs must be spayed or neutered by roughly 7-8 months of age.
4. Any dog with a communicable disease in the past month will require veterinarian documentation of good health before it is admitted.
5. Dogs must have a current daycare/boarding application on file. All dogs must display health and temperament characteristics that are conducive to a fun, safe daycare/boarding environment. We reserve the right to refuse initial service or terminate service at anytime without prior notice and at our sole discretion.
6. Reservations are required. Reservations will be dependent on space availability. Preference will be given to dogs with regular standing reservations.
7. Payments in full for all charges incurred on behalf of a dog are due upon pick-up from daycare or boarding. A deposit or prepayment may be required for some services.
8. Daycare dogs must be picked up before closing.
9. In the event a dog requires emergency veterinary care while at 3 Dogs Boarding and Daycare it will be handled as deemed best by our staff. The dog owner agrees to assume full financial responsibility for any expenses involved.
10. Although all dogs are evaluated for temperament before coming for daycare or boarding, skirmishes and correction bites may still occur. Owner will be responsible for any expenses, for their own pet, that result from such an occurrence.

Boarding Policies

1. All playgroup dogs that are going to be staying overnight must have passed a temperament assessment and come for a day of daycare before their first night of boarding.
2. All private boarding dogs that are going to be staying the night must have come in for a day of daycare before their first night of boarding.
3. Accommodations for private boarding dogs are only available at our Stay Pet Hotel location.
4. Our facilities are set up differently and because of that some dogs may be more comfortable or easier to care for at one location more than the other. If this is determined to be the case by our staff the pet owner will be notified and we may limit reservations to that location only.

5. Reservations are required. Reservations will be dependent on space availability. Preference will be given to dogs with regular standing reservations.
6. **Check-in time is by 12pm**, unless prior arrangements have been made. Dogs that come in late tend to disrupt the daily routine and it's more difficult for them to get settled. Boarding dogs must be checked out by 12pm on the last day or a \$22 daycare charge will be applied.
7. Overnight charges are separate from daycare packages. Daycare packages cannot be used toward overnight boarding charges.
8. Reservations and credit card prepayment in full are required for each stay. Payment is due in full upon arrival for your dogs stay by credit card or cash.
9. Cancellation policy – please call to cancel as soon as you know you will not be bringing your dog for boarding. 48 hours advance notice is required to avoid being charged for your stay.
10. If your dog is not feeling well (coughing, diarrhea, etc.) please call us prior to bringing your dog for boarding, as we are unable to accommodate dogs that are ill. If your dog becomes ill while at 3 Dogs (diarrhea, coughing, etc.) we will seek veterinary care at your expense. If it is determined that your dogs illness is contagious, other arrangements will need to be made for his/her care until no longer contagious. You must provide an emergency contact that can pick up your dog and keep him/her until they are no longer contagious.
11. In the event your dog requires emergency veterinary care while being boarded, it will be handled as deemed best by our daycare staff. You agree to assume full financial responsibility for any expenses involved.
12. Even though all dogs attending our daycare/boarding must receive their Bordatella vaccination every 6-12 months, there is still a possibility they might contract a different strain of kennel cough. Popular boarding times, such as holidays, do pose a greater risk of kennel cough showing up.
13. While boarding your dog, it is important to keep him/her on the same food they are fed regularly at home. Sudden changes in food can lead to diarrhea and discomfort. Therefore, it is necessary for you to bring enough his/her regular food to last the entire stay. If you forget their food or prefer that they eat ours, there will be a \$1/cup food charge.
14. Sometimes during play a dog will get its teeth caught in another dog's collar, therefore all dogs will be collarless while here.
15. Active dogs that have not spent much time on hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt may get friction blisters on the pads of their paws from the rubber mats in daycare on their first or second visit. We monitor the activity of these new dogs and give them frequent rest periods in an attempt to avoid this but it may still happen. We have not yet

seen blisters that needed to be attended by a veterinarian but we will monitor them should this happen during their stay and treat them as deemed necessary including veterinary care should it become necessary.

Agreement and Release

1. I verify that my dog is healthy, has the required vaccinations on file, is free of sickness or disease and to arrange for pickup if contagious illness is suspected.
2. I verify that my dog has not harmed or shown aggression towards people or other dogs.
3. In the event that I cannot be reached by phone, I agree to allow the staff at 3 Dogs Boarding and Daycare/Stay Pet Hotel to transport my dog to Dove Lewis Animal Hospital or Fremont Veterinary Clinic for treatment of any sickness, symptoms, or injuries that occur during daycare/boarding. I also agree to pay for all expenses for any veterinary services or on-site services that result from that occurrence.
4. I have read and understand the policies and agree to abide by them. I certify that I have read and understand this agreement and Release. I agree to accept the terms, conditions and statements of this agreement.
